


<u>Step 2</u>: Login into the Parent Management Server as a domain user with admin privileges. (Federated Deployments)


<u>Login</u> into Management Server as a user with admin privileges (Non-Federated Deployments)



Step 3: Select the RMF plugin from Site Navigation → MIP Plugins




Step 4: Goto Redundancy Configuration under Site Navigation → RMF. Select Modify Failback from the list.



<u>Step 5</u>: **Disabling failback** will not switch to the higher-priority server even if the server is back online. **Enabling failback** will switch to the higher-priority server when the server is back online.



Step 6: Modify the failback as needed. Click **Finish**.



Step 7: Save the changes.
